Recommendations for Student Success



- Student must complete online orientation session before *Cyber School in a Box*TM bundle and textbooks will be issued.
- Student must sign into (and actively participate in) the online homeroom session each day the district is in session.
- Parent/guardian must provide a written excuse to the homeroom teacher for every absence.
- Student must seek academic assistance, when needed, by attending Office Hours and scheduling 1:1 tutoring appointments with his/her teachers.
- Student must obtain technical assistance via the Help Desk, when needed.
- Student must adhere to weekly deadlines (at minimum, student should spend approximately 1-2 hours per course, per day (Monday through Friday)).
- Student and parent/guardian are financially responsible for the Cyber School in a
 Box™ bundle and all textbooks that are issued. No grades or transcripts will be
 released until all obligations are fulfilled.
- Student must adhere to the school district's Code of Conduct.
- Student must report to the designated school building for all mandatory state testing.
- At the end of each 9-week marking period, student must be in good academic standing (passing all courses). Otherwise, student will be required to transfer from the cyber program to the appropriate school district building.
