

NTSD Home Education Students Participation in Cocurricular Activities with a required academic course, CTE programs, and academic courses.

The Northern Tioga School District allows home education students in the district to participate in any cocurricular activity that merges extracurricular activities with a required academic course, CTE programs, and academic courses (equaling up to at least 25% of the school day for full-time district students). To take advantage in these opportunities, the home education student must meet the same eligibility participation criteria and prerequisites (or the equivalent) that apply to full-time NTSD students; and comply with all policies, rules and regulations or their equivalent of the school district.

If a child enrolls in the Northern Tioga School District after homeschooling, there must be a determination of the grade level to which the child is assigned and/or the high school credits that will be awarded. The grade to which the supervisor of the home education program may have assigned their child may not be the same grade in the school to which the child is enrolling. The school will determine the appropriate grade. It is important for a parent to document a student's progress in the form of a written evaluation of the home education program for any time spent in a home education program.

24 P.S. § 13-1327.1(b) requires evidence that homeschooled students have been immunized in accordance with 24 P.S. § 13-1303(a) and the medical services of Article XIV have been received. These are the only items in the list of contents of the affidavit that requests "evidence" beyond the notarized affidavit.

Students taking a class with the Northern Tioga School District by dual enrollment will be assigned a PAsecureID so that they can be counted in the Pennsylvania Information Management System (PIMS).

A home education student residing in the Northern Tioga School District and enrolled in a cocurricular, or academic course shall be included in the average daily membership of the Northern Tioga School District and shall be

calculated by counting the time the home education student spends in the public school. See 24 P.S. § 13-1327.1; see also <u>22 Pa. Code § 11.33Opens In A</u> New Window.

A home education student residing in the Northern Tioga School District and enrolled in the CTE program shall be included in the average daily membership of the Northern Tioga School District and CTC, if applicable, and shall be calculated by counting the time the home education student spends in the CTE program. See 24 P.S. § 13-1327.1; see also 22 Pa. Code § 11.33Opens In A New Window.
