All uses of the network and Internet must be in support of education and consistent with the purposes of the Northern Tioga School District.

All users will adhere to the following rules:

- ✓ You will not reveal your password to anyone. You will not use or attempt to use anyone else's password.
- ✓ You will not use the system for illegal purposes, such as threatening another person, or arranging for the sale or purchase of illegal items.
- ✓ You will not violate the rules of computer etiquette. Some examples of these violations are: Using inflammatory E-mail, using vulgar or obscene language, making ethnic or racial slurs, acting in any manner that is perceived as harassment, or remaining on-line for extended periods of time.
- ✓ You will not intentionally access material that is profane or obscene, that advocates illegal acts, or that advocates violent or discrimination toward other people. If you mistakenly access inappropriate information, you must immediately tell your teacher or the person designated by the District. This will protect you against a claim that you have intentionally violated this policy.
- ✓ You will not change computer files that do not belong to you.
- ✓ You will not plagiarize from the Internet.
- ✓ You will not download files without permission from a supervising teacher.
- ✓ You will not use your account for commercial purposes, which means you may not offer, provide, or purchase products or services through the Internet, or conduct any private business activities.
