Home Education Update

Extracurricular Activities for Home Schooled Students - Act 67 of 2005, requires a school district to allow a resident home schooled student to participate in extracurricular activities offered by the district. These activities include (but are not limited to) clubs, sports, musical ensembles and theatre productions. Participating home schooled students must meet the school district's eligibility criteria, must comply with tryout criteria, and must satisfy all policies, rules and regulations of the governing organization of the activity.

Home schooled students have access to required physical examinations the district provides. The dates and time of those physicals will be posted on the Northern Tioga School District website Home Education Link.
