An aptly stated level of involvement, reflecting not only education today, but also civic engagement and involvement within the upcoming decennial United States 2020 Census.

Beginning within the month, Census 2020 mailings will be delivered via USPS. Census 2020 holds simple goals, yet ones which will affect the next decade. *First*, to assure an accurate count. *Secondly*, to educate the public of Census' safety, security and simplicity. *Thirdly*, to engage trusted civic voices as partners within Census activities. *Lastly*, to work to include Hard-to-Reach audiences and elicit their participation (elderly, collegiate, rural audiences), as well as having parents count children under age 5 (CU>5).

Census 2020 will affect schools, Communities, Municipalities, Counties, service programs and civic services, relied on by the general public through 2030. Population enumeration also affects both Commonwealth of Pennsylvania apportionment, but will affect that of the U.S. Congress. *675 BILLION DOLLARS* of federal discretionary monies will further be allocated according to Census 2020 results.

Civic information, public participation and community engagement hold key to the upcoming 2020 decennial Census.
