Delaware Valley University and Cowanesque Valley High School

Cowanesque Valley High School students who successfully complete the Agriculture Science curriculum can receive college credit from Delaware Valley University for the following courses:

- PS 1120 (3 credits) Sustainability: Saving the Earth and Feeding the People. This course satisfies 3 credits within the Plant Science majors.
- AS 1000 (3 credits) — Survey of Animal Agriculture. This course satisfies requirements 3 credits within the Animal Science major.

Acceptance of the curriculum by Delaware Valley University for these credits is based on the following:

- Cowanesque Valley High School students must successfully complete the Agriculture curriculum with a "B" average or better (3.0 GPA on a 4 point scale).


